- 3. What human traditions (2:8) in your life or church need to be reformed in order to be more faithful to the vision of Christ and His Kingdom?
- 4. What do you need to be careful about to avoid being taken captive by the "elemental spirits of the world" (2:8)?
- 5. Why is it important for our spiritual journey to keep both the death and the resurrection in mind (2:11-15)? What happens if we bypass the death and jump to the resurrection? What happens if we forget the resurrection?
- 6. In times of disappointment, how can we participate in the victory that Christ has already won for us through His resurrection?
