- 1. How does the contemporary social environment make us more vulnerable to the sins listed in vv. 5-9?
- 2. Why do you think that willpower alone (i.e., trying harder) is not enough to put sin to death?
- 3. Have you experienced any victories in putting some sins to death? What has helped you experience such victories?
- 4. Given the polarization in our society today, how can we live out the new reality declared in v. 11?
- 5. Among the virtues listed in vv. 12-17, what is the *one* virtue that you would like to work on for the next six months?
- 6. How does v. 16 inform the ministry of music? How are the ministry of teaching and the ministry of music connected?
- 7. What does it mean to do something "in the name of the Lord Jesus" (v. 17)?
