 - 4. (For wives only) What might submission to your husband look like? Give concrete examples.
 - 5. (For husbands only) What might loving your wife as Christ loved the Church look like? Give concrete examples.
 - 6. How can we teach our children to walk in the way of the Lord without embittering or discouraging them (3:21)?
 - 7. How would you apply the commands in 3:22-4:1 to the relationship between employers and employees in today's work environment?
